

For many years a tax loophole has permitted taxpayers to profit by financially supporting private school voucher programs. This profitable tax shelter has fueled rapid growth in these voucher programs, leading to a major transfer of public dollars into private schools. The IRS has proposed regulations that would shut down this tax shelter and could significantly weaken the popularity and growth of these voucher programs.
